# Fear & Rejection

The subject to fear and rejection is one of my favorites. No, I'm not crazy; it is just that I have seen so many succeed through these emotions, all to be a better person. More mature and better prepared for other challenges ahead. Because the topic is generally perceived as being so negative, the job seeker has a tendency to put this at the forefront. You have got to admit that looking for job or career transition can be quite scary. If you don't have an adequate action plan it can be downright frightening. Remember this tip right from the get go to implement a strong action plan. One must be organized if you are going to reach the goal(s) that you have set. There are factors in the world that are external and internal that will play with your mind and defeat you even before you get started. Your mind is in an emotional wrap drive and you must combat those thoughts with a balance of experience.

Being a Christian, you know this source of this fear and rejection. Yes it is Satan at his best. Anytime you are faced with a challenge or unfamiliar stress, Satan tries to raise his ugly head into your life. This stress can produce an open door for him and his cronies. Doubts, frustration, and depression can come into your life in a moment's notice. Even professionals who are faced with unemployment can be hit with depression and not even know it. Depression sometimes is so subtle it can surprise as and take hold before we even know what has happened.

Understanding the roots of depression, frustration and other negative feelings can help you best deal with them should choose to visit you. Knowing that even best of us face some depression in our lifetime is all the more reason for staying is a strong in the Word. Having a strong spiritual background and support group can make all the difference in the world. Because you're human you need to talk with someone. Having a strong prayer life is obviously most advantageous action you can take. Christian fellowship can also supply needed encouragement when the pressure can become unbearable. You just need someone to talk to.

Most job seekers, even Christians, do not employee an action plan. The world can play numerous head games when you are trying to achieve goal such as employment or a career transition. You must arm yourself or for this battle. It's not too advisable going into battle not armed. Arm yourself with the Word of the Lord, a strong action plan, and a good support group. You will be miles ahead of most job seekers.

Counselors have presented the issue of fear with a variety of attitudes and solutions to deal with it. I'm sure all you've all heard what the letters of fear stand for.

F: False

E: Evidence

A: Appearing

R: Real

False Evidence Appearing Real. That might sound good on the surface but what does that mean to me? Because of the high degree of your emotional state a lot of your fear can be unjustified. Back in the early days there was a fight or flight mentality which demonstrated the positive aspects of fear. If a wild animal is attacking you naturally you will have fear that tells you it's time to take flight or fight. The Lord has instilled this basic instinct and we give him praise for it.

In today's society we take this issue of fear a little bit too liberally. Fear and rejection in this age can mean anything you want to mean. If you have fear is totally unjustified and it someone else's fault. You can be an instant victim should you choose to. But wait! You are Christian! You know the steps to take to deal with your situation and whom to council. The Lord can shed light on your situation and lead you from the perspective of the world into His comfort and guidance.

Either fear controls us or we will control it. There is an excellent book on the market and even though it is secular I encourage strongly to read it if you have a fear issue. *Feel the Fear and Do It Anyway* is an excellent book that has helped numerous clients, not mentioned myself. The most minor things in your life can produce fear, especially if you are not prepared. Accidents, health and financial concerns rank at the top. You must expect the unexpected in life. This also pertains to mental reactions to negative challenges in your life.

Understanding the emotions of fear and rejection are going to play either a minor or major role in your job search. Yes, even Christians will be affected by emotions in one facet or another. All the more reason for a strong prayer life and daily study of the Word. One of my pastors told me that when he is consulting with some of his congregation that are faced with life's challenges, he tells them "they are being prepared and not punished". He encourages throwing away the gilt feelings and moving on. Yes you might stumble and fall down. Just remember to fall *forward*. Most people who go through life's challenges will tell you that they are stronger because of it. The ones who did not fair well are the ones that did not implement a strong action plan coupled with a good support group.

As a career counselor I am always consulting with a few people that are negative about the experiences they've had or are going through. In almost 100 percent of the cases they cannot mention having an action plan, being consistent and persistent with the plan, along with a strong support group/accountability partner. Most don't feel they need any support or are ashamed to ask for help. They feel that they will be out of work for maybe two weeks and then back at work. Some find out that when they are out of work for a month or longer, the lack of not preparing an action plan, coupled with no support group can sometimes be devastating. That is why we have the Lord. That is why the Lord has given us the fellowship of other Christians. What a unique combination in dealing with fear and rejection!

Rejection is another facet of fear. In very few other circumstances is the degree of rejection so prevalent. Think back on your life. What other areas have factors of rejection that loom so large? If you're like most people, personal relationships such as dating, marriage, or divorce could rank as high. What about not being approved for car or home loan? Sad just thinking about it isn't? We all know these situations can happen in our lives, but seldom do most prepared for them.

Understand that you are normal and human. The Lord made you that way. Not only were these challenges before you, but the Lord will provide many solutions on how to deal with them. Stay in the Word! You'll be surprised how many scriptures will jump off the page and address your situation. You can literally open the Bible, point to a scripture and it will address your concern. Maybe not in the individual scripture, but as you read, you will understand how the context is relevant. The Truth will make its presence known. That is one of the most wonderful things about the Word.

If you want to read about someone who had it much worse than you do and made it through with even more blessings, read the book of Job. That should put you back on track. Job lost his "job". Dealt with a spouse's "support" and with his friends "support" and ultimately won back his "job" even greater than before.

Dealing with fear and rejection is not easy. No one has ever said it was, but it can be minimized and controlled. It can be dealt with positively only if you are determined. Let's recap on the suggestions in dealing with fear and rejection.

- 1. Stay strong in the Lord, establish a strong prayer life.....and be in the Word every day.
- 2. Establish a workable daily action plan. Stay consistent and persistent.
- 3. Organize a support group or an accountability person. One or more persons who can encourage you and keep you accountable to your action plan. You can also incorporate a good spiritual leader to assist you with the items 1&2.

Once you find a new position I have come across a unique bonus of going through this "Valley". The Lord will bring others into your life that are going through that same valley. You will then become part of the their support group. You can steer them around the negatives that lie ahead and make their path that much easier. Remember got the Lord put you here for purpose. Not only to succeed in spreading his Word, but helping others in their walk. This process will make you stronger. Not only as a person, but also as a child of God. In gospel song "I Ain't No Ways Tired" the lyrics proclaim "No one said the road would be easy. I don't believe he'd brought me this far to leave me".

- Gen:9:2: And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth, and upon every fowl of the air, upon all that moveth upon the earth, and upon all the fishes of the sea; into your hand are they delivered.
- Gen:19:30: And Lot went up out of Zoar, and dwelt in the mountain, and his two daughters with him; for he feared to dwell in Zoar: and he dwelt in a cave, he and his two daughters.
- Gen:20:11: And Abraham said, Because I thought, Surely the fear of God is not in this place; and they will slay me for my wife's sake.
- Gen:21:17: And God heard the voice of the lad; and the angel of God called Hagar out of heaven, and said unto her, What aileth thee, Hagar? fear not; for God hath heard the voice of the lad where he is.

- Josh:10:2: That they feared greatly, because Gibeon was a great city, as one of the royal cities, and because it was greater than Ai, and all the men thereof were mighty.
- Josh:22:24: And if we have not rather done it for fear of this thing, saying, In time to come your children might speak unto our children, saying, What have ye to do with the LORD God of Israel?
- Josh:22:25: For the LORD hath made Jordan a border between us and you, ye children of Reuben and children of Gad; ye have no part in the LORD: so shall your children make our children cease from fearing the LORD.

- Josh:24:14: Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD.
- Judg:4:18: And Jael went out to meet Sisera, and said unto him, Turn in, my lord, turn in to me; fear not. And when he had turned in unto her into the tent, she covered him with a mantle.
- Judg:6:10: And I said unto you, I am the LORD your God; fear not the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but ye have not obeyed my voice.
- Judg:6:23: And the LORD said unto him, Peace be unto thee; fear not: thou shalt not die.
- Judg:6:27: Then Gideon took ten men of his servants, and did as the LORD had said unto him: and so it was, because he feared his father's household, and the men of the city, that he could not do it by day, that he did it by night.
- Judg:7:3: Now therefore go to, proclaim in the ears of the people, saying, Whosoever is fearful and afraid, let him return and depart early from mount Gilead. And there returned of the people twenty and two thousand; and there remained ten thousand.
- Judg:7:10: But if thou fear to go down, go thou with Phurah thy servant down to the host:
- Judg:8:20: And he said unto Jether his firstborn, Up, and slay them. But the youth drew not his sword: for he feared, because he was yet a youth.
- Judg:9:21: And Jotham ran away, and fled, and went to Beer, and dwelt there, for fear of Abimelech his brother.
- Ruth:3:11: And now, my daughter, fear not; I will do to thee all that thou requirest: for all the city of my people doth know that thou art a virtuous woman.
- 1Sam:3:15: And Samuel lay until the morning, and opened the doors of the house of the LORD. And Samuel feared to shew Eli the vision.
- 1Sam:11:7: And he took a yoke of oxen, and hewed them in pieces, and sent them throughout all the coasts of Israel by the hands of messengers, saying, Whosoever cometh not forth after Saul and after Samuel, so shall it be done unto his oxen. And the fear of the LORD fell on the people, and they came out with one consent.
- 1Sam:12:14: If ye will fear the LORD, and serve him, and obey his voice, and not rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then shall both ye and also the king that reigneth over you continue following the LORD your God:
- 1Sam:12:18: So Samuel called unto the LORD; and the LORD sent thunder and rain that day: and all the people greatly feared the LORD and Samuel.

- 1Sam:12:24: Only fear the LORD, and serve him in truth with all your heart: for consider how great things he hath done for you.
- 1Sam:14:26: And when the people were come into the wood, behold, the honey dropped; but no man put his hand to his mouth: for the people feared the oath.
- 1Sam:15:24: And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.
- 1Sam:21:10: And David arose, and fled that day for fear of Saul, and went to Achish the king of Gath.
- 1Sam:22:23: Abide thou with me, fear not: for he that seeketh my life seeketh thy life: but with me thou shalt be in safeguard.
- 1Sam:23:26: And Saul went on this side of the mountain, and David and his men on that side of the mountain: and David made haste to get away for fear of Saul; for Saul and his men compassed David and his men round about to take them.
- 2Sam:3:11: And he could not answer Abner a word again, because he feared him.
- 2Sam:10:19: And when all the kings that were servants to Hadarezer saw that they were smitten before Israel, they made peace with Israel, and served them. So the Syrians feared to help the children of Ammon any more.
- 2Sam:12:18: And it came to pass on the seventh day, that the child died. And the servants of David feared to tell him that the child was dead: for they said, Behold, while the child was yet alive, we spake unto him, and he would not hearken unto our voice: how will he then vex himself, if we tell him that the child is dead?
- 2Sam:13:28: Now Absalom had commanded his servants, saying, Mark ye now when Amnon's heart is merry with wine, and when I say unto you, Smite Amnon; then kill him, fear not: have not I commanded you? be courageous and be valiant.
- 2Sam:23:3: The God of Israel said, the Rock of Israel spake to me, He that ruleth over men must be just, ruling in the fear of God.
- 1Kgs:1:50: And Adonijah feared because of Solomon, and arose, and went, and caught hold on the horns of the altar.
- 1Kgs:1:51: And it was told Solomon, saying, Behold, Adonijah feareth king Solomon: for, lo, he hath caught hold on the horns of the altar, saying, Let king Solomon swear unto me to day that he will not slay his servant with the sword.

- 1Kgs:3:28: And all Israel heard of the judgment which the king had judged; and they feared the king: for they saw that the wisdom of God was in him, to do judgment.
- 1Kgs:8:40: That they may fear thee all the days that they live in the land which thou gavest unto our fathers.
- 1Kgs:8:43: Hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger calleth to thee for: that all people of the earth may know thy name, to fear thee, as do thy people Israel; and that they may know that this house, which I have builded, is called by thy name.
- 1Kgs:18:3: And Ahab called Obadiah, which was the governor of his house. (Now Obadiah feared the LORD greatly:
- 1Kgs:18:12: And it shall come to pass, as soon as I am gone from thee, that the Spirit of the LORD shall carry thee whither I know not; and so when I come and tell Ahab, and he cannot find thee, he shall slay me: but I thy servant fear the LORD from my youth.
- 2Kgs:4:1: Now there cried a certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets unto Elisha, saying, Thy servant my husband is dead; and thou knowest that thy servant did fear the LORD: and the creditor is come to take unto him my two sons to be bondmen.
- 2Kgs:17:7: For so it was, that the children of Israel had sinned against the LORD their God, which had brought them up out of the land of Egypt, from under the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and had feared other gods,
- 2Kgs:17:25: And so it was at the beginning of their dwelling there, that they feared not the LORD: therefore the LORD sent lions among them, which slew some of them.
- 2Kgs:17:28: Then one of the priests whom they had carried away from Samaria came and dwelt in Bethel, and taught them how they should fear the LORD.
- 2Kgs:17:32: So they feared the LORD, and made unto themselves of the lowest of them priests of the high places, which sacrificed for them in the houses of the high places.
- 2Kgs:17:33: They feared the LORD, and served their own gods, after the manner of the nations whom they carried away from thence.
- 2Kgs:17:34: Unto this day they do after the former manners: they fear not the LORD, neither do they after their statutes, or after their ordinances, or after the law and commandment which the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom he named Israel;
- 2Kgs:17:35: With whom the LORD had made a covenant, and charged them saying, Ye shall not fear other gods, nor bow yourselves to them, nor serve them, nor sacrifice to them:

2Kgs:17:36: But the LORD, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt with great power and a stretched out arm, him shall ye fear, and him shall ye worship, and to him shall ye do sacrifice.

2Kgs:17:37: And the statutes, and the ordinances, and the law, and the commandment, which he wrote for you, ye shall observe to do for evermore; and ye shall not fear other gods.

2Kgs:17:38: And the covenant that I have made with you ye shall not forget; neither shall ye fear other gods.

2Kgs:17:39: But the LORD your God ye shall fear; and he shall deliver you out of the hand of all your enemies.

2Kgs:17:41: So these nations feared the LORD, and served their graven images, both their children, and their children's children: as did their fathers, so do they unto this day.

1Chron:14:17: And the fame of David went out into all lands; and the LORD brought the fear of him upon all nations.

1Chron:16:25: For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised: he also is to be feared above all gods.

1Chron:28:20: And David said to Solomon his son, Be strong and of good courage, and do it: fear not, nor be dismayed: for the LORD God, even my God, will be with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee, until thou hast finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD.

2Chron:6:31: That they may fear thee, to walk in thy ways, so long as they live in the land which thou gavest unto our fathers.

2Chron:6:33: Then hear thou from the heavens, even from thy dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger calleth to thee for; that all people of the earth may know thy name, and fear thee, as doth thy people Israel, and may know that this house which I have built is called by thy name.

2Chron:14:14: And they smote all the cities round about Gerar; for the fear of the LORD came upon them: and they spoiled all the cities; for there was exceeding much spoil in them.

2Chron:17:10: And the fear of the LORD fell upon all the kingdoms of the lands that were round about Judah, so that they made no war against Jehoshaphat.

2Chron:19:7: Wherefore now let the fear of the LORD be upon you; take heed and do it: for there is no iniquity with the LORD our God, nor respect of persons, nor taking of gifts.

2Chron:19:9: And he charged them, saying, Thus shall ye do in the fear of the LORD, faithfully, and with a perfect heart.

2Chron:20:3: And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah.

2Chron:20:17: Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you.

2Chron:20:29: And the fear of God was on all the kingdoms of those countries, when they had heard that the LORD fought against the enemies of Israel.

Ezra:3:3: And they set the altar upon his bases; for fear was upon them because of the people of those countries: and they offered burnt offerings thereon unto the LORD, even burnt offerings morning and evening.

Neh:1:11: O Lord, I beseech thee, let now thine ear be attentive to the prayer of thy servant, and to the prayer of thy servants, who desire to fear thy name: and prosper, I pray thee, thy servant this day, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man. For I was the king's cupbearer.

Neh:5:9: Also I said, It is not good that ye do: ought ye not to walk in the fear of our God because of the reproach of the heathen our enemies?

Neh:5:15: But the former governors that had been before me were chargeable unto the people, and had taken of them bread and wine, beside forty shekels of silver; yea, even their servants bare rule over the people: but so did not I, because of the fear of God.

Neh:6:14: My God, think thou upon Tobiah and Sanballat according to these their works, and on the prophetess Noadiah, and the rest of the prophets, that would have put me in fear.

Neh:6:19: Also they reported his good deeds before me, and uttered my words to him. And Tobiah sent letters to put me in fear.

Neh:7:2: That I gave my brother Hanani, and Hananiah the ruler of the palace, charge over Jerusalem: for he was a faithful man, and feared God above many.

- Esth:8:17: And in every province, and in every city, whithersoever the king's commandment and his decree came, the Jews had joy and gladness, a feast and a good day. And many of the people of the land became Jews; for the fear of the Jews fell upon them.
- Esth:9:2: The Jews gathered themselves together in their cities throughout all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus, to lay hand on such as sought their hurt: and no man could withstand them; for the fear of them fell upon all people.
- Esth:9:3: And all the rulers of the provinces, and the lieutenants, and the deputies, and officers of the king, helped the Jews; because the fear of Mordecai fell upon them.
- Job:1:1: There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil.
- Job:1:8: And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil?
- Job:1:9: Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for nought?
- Job:2:3: And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause.
- Job:3:25: For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me.
- Job:4:6: Is not this thy fear, thy confidence, thy hope, and the uprightness of thy ways?
- Job:6:14: To him that is afflicted pity should be shewed from his friend; but he forsaketh the fear of the Almighty.
- Job:9:34: Let him take his rod away from me, and let not his fear terrify me:
- Job:9:35: Then would I speak, and not fear him; but it is not so with me.
- Job:11:15: For then shalt thou lift up thy face without spot; yea, thou shalt be stedfast, and shalt not fear:
- Job:15:4: Yea, thou castest off fear, and restrainest prayer before God.
- Job:21:9: Their houses are safe from fear, neither is the rod of God upon them.

### New Testament

Mt:1:20: But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

Mt:8:26: And he saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith? Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.

Mt:10:26: Fear them not therefore: for there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known.

Mt:10:28: And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

Mt:10:31: Fear ye not therefore, ye are of more value than many sparrows.

Mt:14:5: And when he would have put him to death, he feared the multitude, because they counted him as a prophet.

Mt:14:26: And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear.

Mt:21:26: But if we shall say, Of men; we fear the people; for all hold John as a prophet.

Mt:21:46: But when they sought to lay hands on him, they feared the multitude, because they took him for a prophet.

Mt:27:54: Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.

Mt:28:4: And for fear of him the keepers did shake, and became as dead men.

Mt:28:5: And the angel answered and said unto the women, Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified.

Mt:28:8: And they departed quickly from the sepulchre with fear and great joy; and did run to bring his disciples word.

Mk:4:40: And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?

- Mk:4:41: And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?
- Mk:5:33: But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before him, and told him all the truth.
- Mk:6:20: For Herod feared John, knowing that he was a just man and an holy, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly.
- Mk:11:18: And the scribes and chief priests heard it, and sought how they might destroy him: for they feared him, because all the people was astonished at his doctrine.
- Mk:11:32: But if we shall say, Of men; they feared the people: for all men counted John, that he was a prophet indeed.
- Mk:12:12: And they sought to lay hold on him, but feared the people: for they knew that he had spoken the parable against them: and they left him, and went their way.
- Lk:1:12: And when Zacharias saw him, he was troubled, and fear fell upon him.
- Lk:1:13: But the angel said unto him, Fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John.
- Lk:1:30: And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God.
- Lk:1:50: And his mercy is on them that fear him from generation to generation.
- Lk:1:65: And fear came on all that dwelt round about them: and all these sayings were noised abroad throughout all the hill country of Judaea.
- Lk:1:74: That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear,
- Lk:2:10: And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.
- Lk:5:10: And so was also James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, which were partners with Simon. And Jesus said unto Simon, Fear not; from henceforth thou shalt catch men.
- Lk:5:26: And they were all amazed, and they glorified God, and were filled with fear, saying, We have seen strange things to day.
- Lk:7:16: And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited his people.

- Lk:8:37: Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and he went up into the ship, and returned back again.
- Lk:8:50: But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole.
- Lk:9:34: While he thus spake, there came a cloud, and overshadowed them: and they feared as they entered into the cloud.
- Lk:9:45: But they understood not this saying, and it was hid from them, that they perceived it not: and they feared to ask him of that saying.
- Lk:12:5: But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell; yea, I say unto you, Fear him.
- Lk:12:7: But even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not therefore: ye are of more value than many sparrows.
- Lk:12:32: Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.
- Lk:18:2: Saying, There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man:
- Lk:18:4: And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man;
- Lk:19:21: For I feared thee, because thou art an austere man: thou takest up that thou layedst not down, and reapest that thou didst not sow.
- Lk:20:19: And the chief priests and the scribes the same hour sought to lay hands on him; and they feared the people: for they perceived that he had spoken this parable against them.
- Lk:21:11: And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven.
- Lk:21:26: Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken.
- Lk:22:2: And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill him; for they feared the people.
- Lk:23:40: But the other answering rebuked him, saying, Dost not thou fear God, seeing thou art in the same condemnation?

- Jn:7:13: Howbeit no man spake openly of him for fear of the Jews.
- Jn:9:22: These words spake his parents, because they feared the Jews: for the Jews had agreed already, that if any man did confess that he was Christ, he should be put out of the synagogue.
- Jn:12:15: Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.
- Jn:19:38: And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave him leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.
- Jn:20:19: Then the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace be unto you.
- Acts:2:43: And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.
- Acts:5:5: And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things.
- Acts:5:11: And great fear came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things.
- Acts:5:26: Then went the captain with the officers, and brought them without violence: for they feared the people, lest they should have been stoned.
- Acts:9:31: Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.
- Acts:10:2: A devout man, and one that feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God alway.
- Acts:10:22: And they said, Cornelius the centurion, a just man, and one that feareth God, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, was warned from God by an holy angel to send for thee into his house, and to hear words of thee.
- Acts:10:35: But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him.
- Acts:13:16: Then Paul stood up, and beckoning with his hand said, Men of Israel, and ye that fear God, give audience.

- Acts:13:26: Men and brethren, children of the stock of Abraham, and whosoever among you feareth God, to you is the word of this salvation sent.
- Acts:16:38: And the serjeants told these words unto the magistrates: and they feared, when they heard that they were Romans.
- Acts:19:17: And this was known to all the Jews and Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified.
- Acts:23:10: And when there arose a great dissension, the chief captain, fearing lest Paul should have been pulled in pieces of them, commanded the soldiers to go down, and to take him by force from among them, and to bring him into the castle.
- Acts:27:17: Which when they had taken up, they used helps, undergirding the ship; and, fearing lest they should fall into the quicksands, strake sail, and so were driven.
- Acts:27:24: Saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee.
- Acts:27:29: Then fearing lest we should have fallen upon rocks, they cast four anchors out of the stern, and wished for the day.
- Rom:3:18: There is no fear of God before their eyes.
- Rom:8:15: For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.
- Rom:11:20: Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear:
- Rom:13:7: Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute is due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.
- 1Cor:2:3: And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling.
- 1Cor:16:10: Now if Timotheus come, see that he may be with you without fear: for he worketh the work of the Lord, as I also do.
- 2Cor:7:1: Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.
- 2Cor:7:5: For, when we were come into Macedonia, our flesh had no rest, but we were troubled on every side; without were fightings, within were fears.
- 2Cor:7:11: For behold this selfsame thing, that ye sorrowed after a godly sort, what carefulness it wrought in you, yea, what clearing of yourselves, yea, what indignation,

- yea, what fear, yea, what vehement desire, yea, what zeal, yea, what revenge! In all things ye have approved yourselves to be clear in this matter.
- 2Cor:7:15: And his inward affection is more abundant toward you, whilst he remembereth the obedience of you all, how with fear and trembling ye received him.
- 2Cor:11:3: But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
- 2Cor:12:20: For I fear, lest, when I come, I shall not find you such as I would, and that I shall be found unto you such as ye would not: lest there be debates, envyings, wraths, strifes, backbitings, whisperings, swellings, tumults:
- Gal:2:12: For before that certain came from James, he did eat with the Gentiles: but when they were come, he withdrew and separated himself, fearing them which were of the circumcision.
- Eph:5:21: Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.
- Eph:6:5: Servants, be obedient to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ;
- Phil:1:14: And many of the brethren in the Lord, waxing confident by my bonds, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.
- Phil:2:12: Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.
- Col:3:22: Servants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God:
- 1Tm:5:20: Them that sin rebuke before all, that others also may fear.
- 2Tm:1:7: For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- Heb:2:15: And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.
- Heb:4:1: Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it.
- Heb:5:7: Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared:

- Heb:10:27: But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.
- Heb:10:31: It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.
- Heb:11:7: By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.
- Heb:11:27: By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.
- Heb:12:21: And so terrible was the sight, that Moses said, I exceedingly fear and quake:)
- Heb:12:28: Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:
- Heb:13:6: So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.
- 1Pt:1:17: And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear:
- 1Pt:2:17: Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.
- 1Pt:2:18: Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward.
- 1Pt:3:2: While they behold your chaste conversation coupled with fear.
- 1Pt:3:15: But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:
- 1Jn:4:18: There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.
- Jude:1:12: These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots;
- Jude:1:23: And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.
- Rv:1:17: And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:

- Rv:2:10: Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.
- Rv:11:11: And after three days and an half the Spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.
- Rv:11:18: And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth.
- Rv:14:7: Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.
- Rv:15:4: Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest.
- Rv:18:10: Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come.
- Rv:18:15: The merchants of these things, which were made rich by her, shall stand afar off for the fear of her torment, weeping and wailing,
- Rv:19:5: And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both small and great.
- Rv:21:8: But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.
