

# Called to Purpose: A 3-Day Guided Prayer to Prepare Spiritually Before Interviews

## Day 1: God Goes Before You

**Scripture Focus:** “The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you.” — Deuteronomy 31:8 (NIV)

**Devotional Thought:** Before you walk into that interview room (or log in to that virtual call), know this: God has already gone before you. Your future is not a mystery to Him—it’s already held in His hands. Though anxiety may rise, you are not walking into the unknown alone. God is already working in the hearts of those you’ll meet. He knows your worth because He created it. This isn’t just about a job—it’s about purpose. You were designed for impact, and every interview is an opportunity for that purpose to shine through your words, actions, and presence.

**Prayer Prompt:** Lord, I surrender this opportunity to You. Go before me and make the way clear. Calm my fears and help me trust that You are in control. Prepare the hearts of those who will hear me speak. Let them see You in me.

**Action Step:** Write down 3 qualities God has uniquely placed in you. Reflect on how those gifts could be a blessing in a workplace setting.

## Day 2: Confidence Rooted in Calling

**Scripture Focus:** “For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things He planned for us long ago.” — Ephesians 2:10 (NLT)

**Devotional Thought:** Confidence doesn’t come from your resume, degrees, or eloquence—it comes from your calling. You were made on purpose, for a purpose. The gifts and experiences you carry are not accidental—they are tools God will use to build His kingdom, even in the workplace. When you walk into that interview, you carry the Spirit of God with you. Let that be your confidence. You’re not auditioning for worth—you’re stewarding the purpose God already placed in you.

**Prayer Prompt:** Father, thank You for creating me as Your masterpiece. Help me walk in boldness—not arrogance, but holy confidence in Your calling. Open the right doors and close the wrong ones. Let my heart stay fixed on You.

**Action Step:** Practice introducing yourself aloud, but instead of just reciting your experience, include how your faith has shaped your career journey.

## Day 3: Peace in His Presence

**Scripture Focus:** “Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.” — Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV)

**Devotional Thought:** As the interview approaches, anxiety may whisper lies: You're not enough. You'll mess up. They won't choose you. But God whispers truth: You are mine. I will give you peace. I will be with you. When your heart is anchored in God's presence, your peace doesn't depend on outcomes. Whether the interview leads to a job or not, you can walk away knowing you were faithful, and He is still good.

**Prayer Prompt:** Jesus, still my anxious thoughts. Remind me that peace isn't found in performance, but in Your presence. Thank You for being with me, guiding every word and thought. I trust You with the outcome.

**Action Step:** Before the interview, sit quietly for five minutes in prayer or worship. Breathe deeply and repeat: 'God is with me. I am called to purpose.'
