### A 3-Day Devotional on Witnessing Through Work

#### Day 1 – Work as Worship

**Scripture:**

*"Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters."*

— Colossians 3:23 (NIV)

**Reflection:**

Our workplaces are not just job sites—they are mission fields. When we shift our mindset from earning a paycheck to glorifying God through excellence, our work becomes worship. ### **Day 3 – Faithful with Influence**

**Scripture:**

*"Now it is required that those who have been given a trust must prove faithful."*  
— 1 Corinthians 4:2 (NIV)

**Reflection:**

God places us in roles and relationships not by accident, but by design. Whether you supervise teams or simply show up faithfully each day, you carry influence. Leadership in the kingdom of God isn't about status—it's about stewardship. When you honor God with your influence—big or small—you open doors for Him to move in your workplace.

**Prayer:**

*God, thank You for the trust You've given me in my work. Help me to be faithful with the influence I carry. Show me how to lead with integrity, humility, and compassion. May my faith be visible, not loud—bold, but gentle.*
