

Seasoned Speech:

A 3-Day Devotional on Communication, Honesty, and Confidence

Day 1 – Speaking with Grace

Scripture:

"Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone."

— Colossians 4:6 (NIV)

Reflection:

Our words carry weight—far more than we often realize. When Scripture tells us to let our words be “seasoned with salt,” it points to language that preserves, enhances, and brings truth. Grace-filled speech isn’t soft or passive; it’s wise, intentional, and constructive. Whether in difficult conversations or everyday chatter, our goal is to reflect the heart of Christ with our tone, timing, and truth.

Prayer:

Lord, help me to speak words that give life. Teach me to respond thoughtfully and wisely. Let my communication reflect Your patience and Your power. Fill my heart so fully with Your Spirit that grace naturally seasons all I say.

Day 2 – Walking in Truth

Scripture:

"Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to your neighbor, for we are all members of one body."

— Ephesians 4:25 (NIV)

Reflection:

Truth is the foundation of trust. In a world blurred by half-truths and performance, God calls us to radical honesty—not just in what we say, but how we live. Speaking truth may require courage, but it always fosters freedom. Our honesty honors God and protects unity. When we speak truth in love, we model Christ, who never compromised integrity for popularity.

Prayer:

God of Truth, purify my words. Let no deceit pass my lips. When it's easier to stay silent or

twist the truth, remind me that You are my confidence and my guide. Help me build relationships that are rooted in honesty and mutual respect.

Day 3 – Confidence in Christ

Scripture:

"On the day I called, you answered me; my strength of soul you increased."

— Psalm 138:3 (ESV)

Reflection:

God doesn't only care *what* we say, but *how* we say it. Confidence in communication doesn't come from charisma—it flows from conviction. When we remember who we are in Christ, we speak with a quiet boldness. Whether testifying of God's goodness, advocating for justice, or simply introducing ourselves in a new space, our words reflect whose we are. Confidence grounded in Christ replaces fear with faith.

Prayer:

Father, strengthen my spirit when I feel uncertain. Remind me that I am chosen, called, and equipped. Let my confidence come from knowing You walk with me. Make me bold in sharing truth, tender in listening, and faithful in representing You well.
