#### 75 Jobs With Flexible Hours

If you're tired of the 9-to-5 grind, you're not alone. Fortunately, jobs with flexible hours are on the rise, in part due to the increasing awareness of the importance of work-life balance, the growth of the gig economy, and the improvement of telecommuting and remote collaboration tools.

Before you start looking for a job with flexible hours, there are a couple of things you need to know:

How do flexible hours work? Before you start looking for a job with flexible hours, determine what you're looking for, specifically. "Flexible hours" is an umbrella term that is used to describe multiple different schedules.

It could mean that you are required to work a number of hours, but it is up to you when you complete these hours. For example, a company might allow its full-time employees to work whenever they want (rather than from 9 am to 6 pm) to fulfill their 40 hours.

Or, in the case of freelance or contract work, you might be assigned a project and work as many hours as needed to complete it, thereby setting your own schedule. Lastly, in the case of 'gig' jobs (think driving for a rideshare company, tutoring on the side, pet sitting, etc.) you might be able to work as little or as often as you choose, although keep in mind there will often be maximum or minimum hour requirements depending on company policies or expectations.

What's the best way to find a job with flexible hours? You can start by familiarizing yourself with the job titles below. It's important to note that not all of the jobs listed below will always have the benefit of flexible hours; there are many other factors at play that will determine this. In general, though, jobs that don't require real-time collaboration with other people will be more likely to have flexible hours than those that do.

In addition, jobs that can be done remotely (and don't require you to come into an office) are often more likely to have flexible hours.

# **Technical Jobs**

Jobs in the technology industry are among some of the most common types of jobs with flexible hours, due in part to the fact that they can often be done remotely, and because there is a lot of freelance and contract work available in this industry.

Rather, you'd have flexibility beyond the typical 9-to-5 schedule.
